There may be other charges; for example, Dormitory Breakage Deposit of \$65, Student Insurance of \$358, or Late Fees if invoice is not paid on time (or if arrangements to pay the bill have not yet been made with the business office) of \$50. If you take courses at another University of Maine System Campus, or on-line Courses, tuition and fee charges may differ from the above examples. The above figures should be considered as an estimate.

These are the charges you will be paying to the University and which will appear on your Invoice once you have registered. Remember that you will have additional costs for books and supplies each semester (estimated to be \$515 on average each semester.) Also, if you do not live on campus, you may have living expenses and all students will also have transportation and personal expenses during the year.
